

REGLAMENTO (CE) N° 459/2009 DE LA COMISIÓN**de 29 de mayo de 2009****que modifica el Reglamento (CE) n° 1249/96 por el que se establecen disposiciones de aplicación del Reglamento (CEE) n° 1766/92 del Consejo en lo que concierne a los derechos de importación en el sector de los cereales**

LA COMISIÓN DE LAS COMUNIDADES EUROPEAS,

(2) Procede, por tanto, modificar el Reglamento (CE) n° 1249/96 en consecuencia.

Visto el Tratado constitutivo de la Comunidad Europea,

Visto el Reglamento (CE) n° 1234/2007 del Consejo, de 22 de octubre de 2007, por el que se crea una organización común de mercados agrícolas y se establecen disposiciones específicas para determinados productos agrícolas (Reglamento único para las OCM) ⁽¹⁾, y, en particular, su artículo 143, letra b), leído en relación con su artículo 4,

(3) Las medidas previstas en el presente Reglamento se ajustan al dictamen del Comité de gestión de la organización común de mercados agrícolas.

Considerando lo siguiente:

HA ADOPTADO EL PRESENTE REGLAMENTO:

Artículo 1(1) En el anexo IV bis del Reglamento (CE) n° 1249/96 de la Comisión ⁽²⁾ figuran los modelos de certificado de conformidad autorizados por el Gobierno de los Estados Unidos de América en lo que atañe a las exportaciones de trigo blando de alta calidad y de trigo duro de alta calidad a la Comunidad Europea. Las autoridades estadounidenses han informado a los servicios de la Comisión de una modificación de sus modelos nacionales. Es preciso, pues, adaptar dichos modelos.

El anexo IV bis del Reglamento (CE) n° 1249/96 se sustituye por el texto que figura en el anexo del presente Reglamento.

*Artículo 2*El presente Reglamento entrará en vigor el tercer día siguiente al de su publicación en el *Diario Oficial de la Unión Europea*.

El presente Reglamento será obligatorio en todos sus elementos y directamente aplicable en cada Estado miembro.

The certificate shall not be considered representative of the lot if the grain is transhipped or is otherwise transferred from the identified carrier or container or if grain or other material is added to or removed from the total lot. If this certificate is not canceled by a superseding certificate, it is receivable by all officers and all courts of the United States as prima facie evidence of the truth of the facts stated therein. This certificate does not excuse failure to comply with the provisions of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act or other Federal law.
